# How to set "Visibility of the app on Facebook"

Facebook setting should be done prior to the GY-HM250 setting. If you want to set to "Visiblity of the app on Facebook" (Public, Friends, or Only Me), be sure to make the setting both on Facebook and the GY-HM250.
